We had 39.5 mls in 24 hours on Wednesday 29th and experienced minor washouts, but I see there is destruction on the main Road to Mannum. This will take some time to rectify. The hay crop that is being share farmed on our place was cut by the contractor the Monday and Tuesday prior, so we have now got our fingers crossed and praying for the good sunny weather to continue for a bit for the hay to have a chance at being salvaged ☹️

Lamb Stuff: *Average Weights:* of the Lambs are 26 kgs and Mutton is 35 kgs.

Availability: We still have a number of lambs available for delivery on the 18th November and if I haven't already contacted you and you are after some, please let me know by midday, Friday the 8th October. Otherwise, they will be going to TFI where they are paying quite good money for them at the moment. The next lot of lamb will be available in April.

We are at the tail end of our lambing season and we have had 4 sets of triplets that are all doing very well. Due to this we have had an almost 200% drop with the girls.



Beef Stuff: *Average Weights:* were 105 kgs a side. One of the animals included in these weights was 17 months old so he lifted the average a bit 😊

Availability: Our beef numbers have dropped further as we slowly try to edge our way into retirement but we do have 3 more going off early next year. As we get closer, I will contact those fortunate to be on the list.

Winter hides just in: We have just gotten these 2 beautiful black and white hides back from the tanners. These are the last of the black and whites that we will be getting tanned. I still have to catalogue them properly, with the first one being a bit smaller than the second. If you are interested, contact me for more details and I should have the sizing for you.



Salami orders: Around mid to late November, I will be putting in an order for salamis with a delivery time of early December – dependent on Kalleske’s delivery timetable. I will be contacting our regular salami clients but if you would like to be added to the list, let me know. I don’t have confirmed prices yet but last year’s prices were:

‘5 ft’ garlic or plain mettwursts - \$40

‘4 ft’ pepperonis - \$21

Pack 6 Beir or Pepperoni sticks and pack of 8 Twiggys sticks, Beir or Pepperoni - \$6.50.
